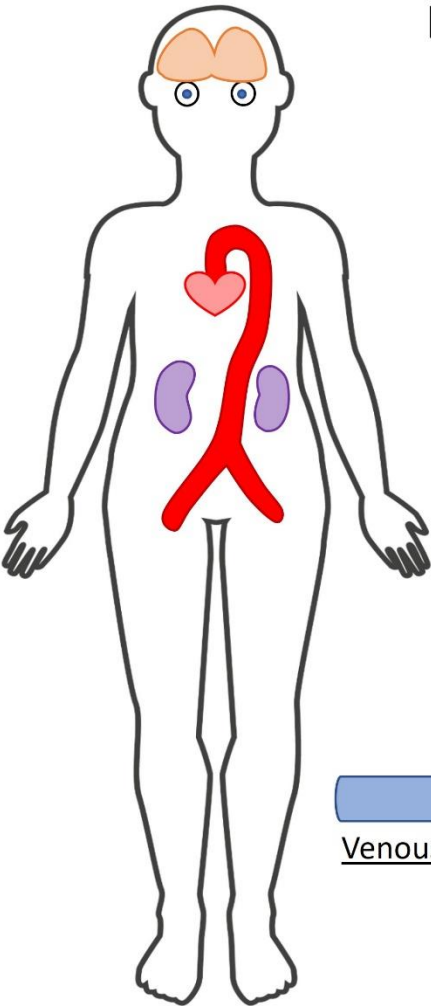
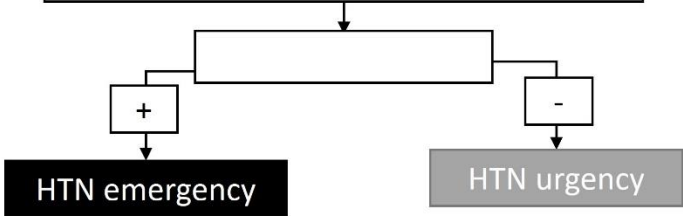


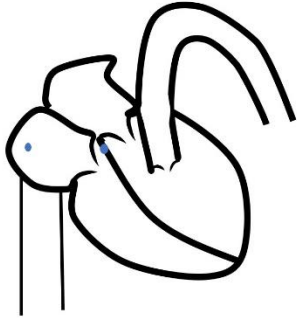

1. Hypertensive encephalopathy
2. IPH or SAH
3. Ischemic CVA

Cardiac

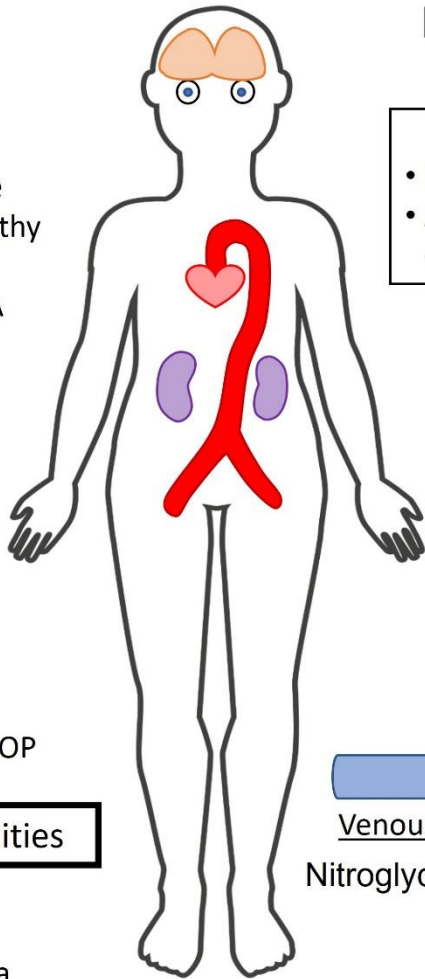
1. Acute LV failure
2. ACS
3. Aortic dissection

Renal

Rapidly ↑ Cr ± ↓ UOP

Other Comorbidities

1. Eclampsia
2. Pheochromocytoma
3. Ingestion of sympathomimetic agents



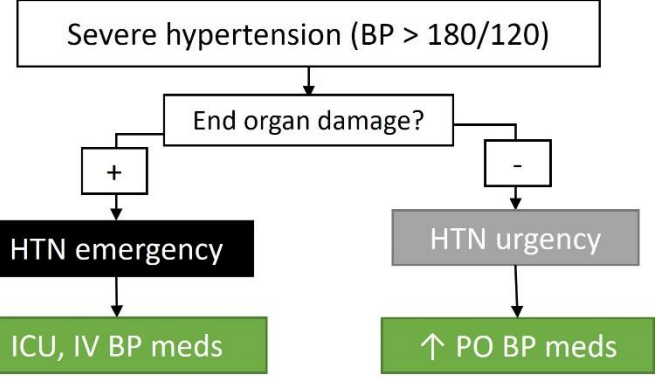
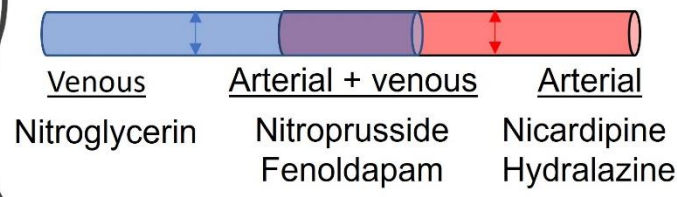
SPECIAL

- IPH/SAH – SBP <140 ASAP
- Aortic dissection – HR 60, SBP <120 ASAP

GENERAL

- 1st h – ↓ BP by <25%
- 4-6 h – BP <160/100
- >24-48 h – BP <140/90
